On **TUESDAY, AUGUST 5, 2014**, the Arroyo Grande Planning Commission will conduct a public hearing at **6:00 P.M.** in the **COUNCIL CHAMBERS** at **215 E. BRANCH STREET** to consider the following:

CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT NO. 14-007; CHEVRON SERVICE STATION FAÇADE MODIFICATION AND BUILDING EXPANSION; LOCATION – 251 EAST GRAND AVENUE; APPLICANT – PREMIER FUEL GROUP, INC.; REPRESENTATIVE – KYLE HARRIS, HARRIS ARCHITECTURE & DESIGN


The Planning Commission will consider an application for a Conditional Use Permit to add 469 square-feet of building area to the existing service station and update the building façade.

In compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the Community Development Department has determined that the above project is categorically exempt per Section 15301(e) of the CEQA Guidelines. If the Planning Commission does not feel that this determination is appropriate, project approval will not be considered.

The Planning Commission may also discuss other hearings or business items before or after the item listed above. If you challenge the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Planning Commission at, or prior to, the public hearing. Comments may be either: (1) mailed or delivered in person to the Community Development Department at 300 East Branch Street, Arroyo Grande, CA or (2) provided in person at the Public Hearing.

Failure of any person to receive the notice shall not constitute grounds for any court to invalidate the action of the legislative body for which the notice was given.
