


**CITY OF ARROYO GRANDE

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

On **TUESDAY, MAY 22, 2018**, the Arroyo Grande City Council will conduct a public hearing at **6:00 P.M.** in the **COUNCIL CHAMBERS** at **215 E. BRANCH STREET** to consider the following item:

ARROYO GRANDE TOURISM BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT (AGTBID). The City Council will: 1) hold a public hearing to receive testimony regarding the City Council's intention to continue the Arroyo Grande Tourism Business Improvement District (AGTBID) and levy an annual assessment for fiscal year 2018-19; 2) determine whether a legally sufficient number of protests have been made; and 3) if a legally sufficient protest is not made, adopt a Resolution confirming the Advisory Board's report and levying an annual assessment for the AGTBID for the 2018-19 fiscal year.

The Council may also discuss other hearings or business items before or after the items listed above. If you challenge the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council at, or prior to, the public hearing. Failure of any person to receive the notice shall not constitute grounds for any court to invalidate the action of the legislative body for which the notice was given.
