**CONSTRUCTION NOTICE; RESTRIPING OF TRAFFIC WAY
TRAFFIC WAY STREETScape PROJECT**


The Traffic Way Streetscape Project is nearly complete. The project scope of work included the installation of sidewalks along Traffic Way and Station Way, minor drainage improvements, roadway striping and widening along the southerly portion of East Cherry Avenue to enable the installation of a dedicated left turn lane.

Toste Construction, a subcontractor to California Coastal Development, will perform striping operations for the Traffic Way Streetscape Project **between Monday, April 27th and Thursday, April 30th**. The work will improve traffic circulation on Traffic Way and the northern portion of Station Way by reconfiguring the roadway from four to three lanes. New bike lanes will be incorporated on each side of Traffic Way and a two-way left turn median or dedicated left turn lane will be included at each public street intersection. The reconfiguration includes relocation of the stop bar on Station Way, approximately 12 feet eastward into the Traffic Way intersection, to improve the driver's sight line when looking northward to the Traffic Way bridge. New striping will also be performed on East Cherry Avenue to delineate the newly constructed dedicated left turn lane.
