**CHANGE IN BURN DAY SCHEDULE FOR THE CITY OF ARROYO GRANDE**

The City of Arroyo Grande has changed their burn schedule to accommodate the residents who purchase burn permits.

Effective immediately the City of Arroyo Grande is allowing burning each Saturday and Sunday during the months of January – June and November and December. Burning shall be allowed on properties of one acre or greater and between 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

In the past the City of Arroyo Grande has only allowed residents to burn two weekends of each month during January – June and November and December. To comply with the guidelines of the Air Pollution Control District (APCD), permit holders must contact APCD to verify that it is a permissive burn day in the county. Much of the time it is not a permissive burn day, therefore, burn days in the city were very limited.

Residents may obtain a valid burn permit at the Arroyo Grande Fire Department, 140 Traffic Way, Arroyo Grande. The permit fee is \$100 and expires one year from the date of issuance.
