The City of Arroyo Grande will be hosting a public workshop to present, discuss and receive public input on the Critical Needs Action Plan. The workshop will take place on Thursday, May 27th at 6:00 p.m. at the Woman's Club and City of Arroyo Grande Community Center, located at 211 Vernon Street in Arroyo Grande.

The City is developing a Critical Needs Action Plan, which will establish major priorities for the City. These areas will serve as the priority for City financial and staff resources over the next few years. The purpose of the plan is to help the City address important community needs, but ensure they are funded in a responsible way to maintain the City in a financially solvent position. The workshop is an opportunity to learn about these priority efforts and to provide public input. Key issues that will be discussed include:
