SUBJECT: DISCUSSION OF PLAN TO INSTALL ADDITIONAL PEDESTRIAN SAFETY MEASURES IN THE VILLAGE

DATE: SEPTEMBER 4, 2019

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Downtown Parking Advisory Board (DPAB) receive a presentation on the City's plan to install additional flashing beacons at two intersections on Branch Street in the Village.

IMPACT ON FINANCIAL AND PERSONNEL RESOURCES:

No financial impacts identified.

ANALYSIS OF ISSUES:

City staff has been requested to install additional pedestrian safety measures in the Village. The Staff Advisory Committee has recommended the installation of additional in-ground mound lights and vertical flashing crosswalk lights at the intersections of East Branch Street and Nevada St/Bridge Street and East Brach Street at Short Street. Bill Robeson, Public Works Director has advised that the tentative schedule for installation of additional flashing beacons is during the month of September.
