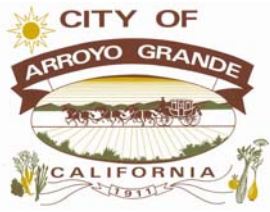

**ARROYO GRANDE CITY CHARTER ADVISORY COMMITTEE HONORED**

ARROYO GRANDE, CALIFORNIA – The City of Arroyo Grande City Charter Advisory Committee recently completed its recommendations and members were recognized at the January 14, 2014 City Council meeting. The makeup of the Committee was designed to provide a broad range of community representation and included the following individuals: Tom Goss, Patricia Hardy, Vard Ikeda, Kirk Scott, Randy Steiger, Bob Lund, Zachary Hall, Andrea Montes, Duke Sterling, John Keen and Judith Bean, who served as the Chair.

The purpose of the City Charter Advisory Committee was to develop recommendations on the draft City Charter and whether or not to proceed to place a measure on the ballot. The Committee was formed after the City Council delayed the process following two public hearings in 2012 in order to obtain more public involvement. The Committee began meeting in March 2013. Seven meetings were held. All meetings were open to the public, publicly noticed, and a number of individuals attended the meetings and provided input. The Committee's recommendations were also presented to the City Council for consideration at the January 14, 2014 meeting. The City Council approved proceeding with the process with minor modifications to the document.
