NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

On **TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 11, 2014**, the Arroyo Grande City Council will conduct a public hearing at **6:00 P.M.** in the **COUNCIL CHAMBERS** at **215 E. BRANCH STREET** to consider the following:

DEVELOPMENT CODE AMENDMENT 14-001; LOCATION – CITYWIDE; APPLICANT – CITY OF ARROYO GRANDE. The City Council will consider a proposed Ordinance repealing Chapter 13.24 of the Arroyo Grande Municipal Code in its entirety and adopting a new Chapter 13.24 regulating excavation, grading, erosion and sediment control; adding a new Chapter 25 to Title 13 regulating illegal discharges and illicit connections; and adding a new Section to Title 16, Chapter 68 regarding design requirements for post construction stormwater compliance. In compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the Community Development Department has determined that the proposed project is categorically exempt per Section 15308 of the CEQA Guidelines regarding actions by regulatory agencies for the protection of the environment. If the City Council does not feel that this determination is appropriate, project approval will not be considered.

The City Council may also discuss other hearings or business items before or after the item listed above. If you challenge the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council at, or prior to, the public hearing. Comments may be either: (1) mailed or delivered in person to the Community Development Department at 300 East Branch Street, Arroyo Grande, CA or (2) provided in person at the Public Hearing. Failure of any person to receive the notice shall not constitute grounds for any court to invalidate the action of the legislative body for which the notice was given.
