ARROYO GRANDE VILLAGE PUBLIC ART MURAL

ARROYO GRANDE, CALIFORNIA - The City of Arroyo Grande would like to invite the public to view the new mural in the Village of Arroyo Grande on Saturday, July 26, 2014 from 11:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. The mural, located on the east wall of the building at 303 E. Branch Street, was painted by artist Colleen Mitchell-Veyna and is the first project of the City's Public Art Program. The mural features some aspects of life in Arroyo Grande in the early to mid-1900s: a narrow gauge railroad, which was used to ship produce from the community, and depictions of farmers surrounded by vegetables, wine grapes and fields. Members of the Arroyo Grande Public Art Committee will be available to provide background information on the mural and the artist.
