





NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

On **TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 9, 2014**, the Arroyo Grande City Council will conduct a public hearing at **6:00 P.M.** in the **COUNCIL CHAMBERS** at **215 E. BRANCH STREET** to consider the following item:

PUBLIC ART - STAFF PROJECT 14-005; LOCATION – A JAPANESE LANTERN AT 150 SOUTH COURTLAND STREET, ARROYO GRANDE; APPLICANT: PEOPLES’ SELF HELP HOUSING AND ARROYO GRANDE PUBLIC ART COMMITTEE. The City Council will receive public input and comment on an art proposal, a Japanese lantern located at 150 South Courtland Street in Arroyo Grande. The purpose of the hearing is to provide an opportunity for the community to comment on the proposal. No action will be taken by the Council. After the hearing, the art proposal will be referred to a public art panel in accordance with the City’s Public Art Guidelines.

The City Council may also discuss other hearings or business items before or after the item listed above. If you challenge the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council at, or prior to, the public hearing. Comments may be either: (1) mailed or delivered in person to the Community Development Department at 300 East Branch Street, Arroyo Grande, CA or (2) provided in person at the Public Hearing. Failure of any person to receive the notice shall not constitute grounds for any court to invalidate the action of the legislative body for which the notice was given.
