ARROYO GRANDE SWINGING BRIDGE TEMPORARY CLOSURE

The Arroyo Grande Swinging Bridge located in Olohan Alley near the Village of Arroyo Grande is closed until necessary repairs are completed. Maintenance and repair needs were identified following a recent bridge inspection conducted by City staff. A projected completion date for the indentified repairs has not yet been determined because special equipment will be required to access locations under the bridge in the creek channel. Pedestrian access across Arroyo Grande Creek in the Village is available at Mason Street to the east and Bridge Street to the west.

Arroyo Grande Swinging Bridge Background

The swinging bridge was originally constructed in early 1875 by the Short family, whose land was divided by the Arroyo Grande Creek. The bridge spans a total length 171 feet and is suspended 40 feet above the creek. The bridge is owned and maintained by the City of Arroyo Grande and is the only one of its kind in California.
