


**CITY OF ARROYO GRANDE

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

On **TUESDAY, JANUARY 24, 2017**, the Arroyo Grande City Council will conduct a public hearing at **6:00 P.M.** in the **COUNCIL CHAMBERS** at **215 E. BRANCH STREET, ARROYO GRANDE** to consider the following items:

1. **2015 URBAN WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN UPDATE.** The City Council will consider adoption of an amended 2015 Urban Water Management Plan (UWMP). The 2015 UWMP contains a revised water shortage contingency analysis that was updated since the 2015 UWMP was adopted on June 30, 2016. The UWMP describes and evaluates sources of supply, reasonable and practical efficient uses and demand management activities; it includes a description of the City's water facilities, projected water supply, projected water use, water conservation programs, revised water shortage contingency analysis and supplemental water supply opportunities. In compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the City of Arroyo Grande Community Development Department has determined that this action is exempt pursuant to Section 15282(v) of the CEQA Guidelines. If the City Council does not feel that this determination is appropriate, project approval will not be considered.
2. **PROPOSED ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13.07 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO STAGES OF WATER SHORTAGE EMERGENCIES TO IMPLEMENT EMERGENCY WATER SHORTAGE RESTRICTIONS AND REGULATIONS.** The City Council will consider a proposed Ordinance amending Chapter 13.07 of the Municipal Code to be consistent with the Urban Water Management Plan and the State's requirements relating to stages of action and to otherwise provide for Triggering Conditions for Stage 1 and Stage 2 water shortage emergencies.

The City Council may also discuss other hearings or business items before or after the item listed above. If you challenge the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council at, or prior to, the public hearing. Comments may be either: (1) mailed to or hand delivered to the Public Works Department, 300 East Branch Street, Arroyo Grande, CA 93420; or (2) provided in person at the public hearing. Failure of any person to receive the notice shall not constitute grounds for any court to invalidate the action of the legislative body for which the notice was given.
