On **TUESDAY, JUNE 6, 2017**, the Arroyo Grande Planning Commission will conduct a public hearing at **6:00 P.M.** in the **COUNCIL CHAMBERS** at **215 E. BRANCH STREET** to consider the following:

**CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT 17-002; APPROXIMATELY 5,000 SQUARE FOOT ADDITION TO THE ARROYO GRANDE HOSPITAL EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT; LOCATION – 345 SOUTH HALCYON ROAD; APPLICANT – DIGNITY HEALTH; REPRESENTATIVE – TODD SMITH, CANNON**


The Planning Commission will consider an application for a conditional use permit, authorizing the expansion of Arroyo Grande Hospital's Emergency Department by 4,975 square feet and associated improvements to the site.

In compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the Community Development Department has determined that the project is exempt per Section 15301(e)(2) of the Guidelines regarding additions to existing structures.

The Planning Commission may also discuss other hearings or business items before or after the item listed above. If you challenge the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Planning Commission at, or prior to, the public hearing. Comments may be either: (1) mailed or delivered in person to the Community Development Department at 300 East Branch Street, Arroyo Grande, CA or (2) provided in person at the Public Hearing.

Failure of any person to receive the notice shall not constitute grounds for any court to invalidate the action of the legislative body for which the notice was given.
