





NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

On **TUESDAY, OCTOBER 9, 2018** the Arroyo Grande City Council will conduct a public hearing at **6:00 P.M.** in the **COUNCIL CHAMBERS** at **215 E. BRANCH STREET** to consider the following:

**A PROPOSED ORDINANCE MAKING ADMINISTRATIVE UPDATES TO VARIOUS SECTIONS OF TITLE 2 (ADMINISTRATION AND PERSONNEL), TITLE 10 (VEHICLES & TRAFFIC), TITLE 12 (STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND PUBLIC PLACES) AND TITLE 16 (DEVELOPMENT CODE) OF THE ARROYO GRANDE MUNICIPAL CODE.** The City Council will consider amendments to various sections of Titles 2, 10, 12, and 16 of the Municipal Code to reassign duties previously assigned to the Parks and Recreation Commission, Traffic Commission, and Historic Resources Committee to the Community Development Director, Recreation Services Director, and/or Public Works Director, Planning Commission, and/or City Council. The City of Arroyo Grande Planning Commission has recommended adoption of the Ordinance. In compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the Community Development Department has determined that the project is exempt per Section 15061(b)(3) of the CEQA Guidelines.

The City Council may also discuss other hearings or business items before or after the item listed above. If you challenge the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council at, or prior to, the public hearing. Comments may be either: (1) mailed or delivered in person to the Community Development Department at 300 East Branch Street, Arroyo Grande, CA or (2) provided in person at the Public Hearing. Failure of any person to receive the notice shall not constitute grounds for any court to invalidate the action of the legislative body for which the notice was given.
