On **TUESDAY, AUGUST 20, 2019**, the Arroyo Grande Planning Commission will conduct a public hearing at **6:00 P.M.** in the **COUNCIL CHAMBERS** at **215 E. BRANCH STREET** to consider the following:

CONSIDERATION OF APPEAL TO PLANNING COMMISSION CASE 19-003; APPEAL OF PLOT PLAN REVIEW 19-016 FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A VACATION RENTAL; LOCATION – 648 PASEO STREET; APPELLANT – DEL & MARY HELEN SWEET, ET. AL. The Planning Commission will consider an appeal of the Community Development Director's approval of Plot Plan Review 19-016 to establish a vacation rental at 648 Paseo Street. In compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the Community Development Department determined that the project is categorically exempt per Section 15301 of the CEQA Guidelines regarding existing facilities.

The Planning Commission may also discuss other hearings or business items before or after the item listed above. If you challenge the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Planning Commission at, or prior to, the public hearing. Comments may be either: (1) mailed or delivered in person to the Community Development Department at 300 East Branch Street, Arroyo Grande, CA or (2) provided in person at the Public Hearing. Failure of any person to receive the notice shall not constitute grounds for any court to invalidate the action of the legislative body for which the notice was given.
